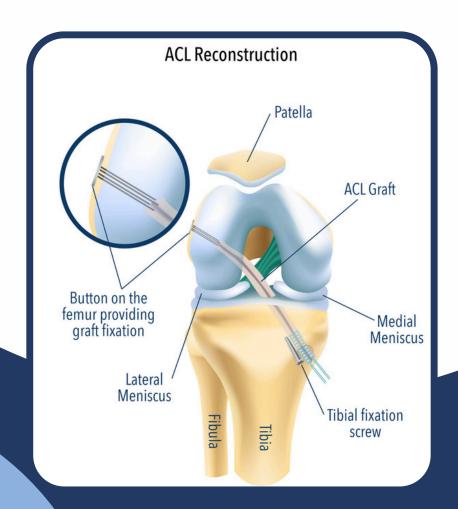


## **How Can You Get Your**

When you get your ACL torn while playing sports, you feel pain, instability, and have trouble moving your knee. During the surgery, your doctor would take one or two of these tendons and use them to replace your torn ACL. This method is commonly practised because it usually causes less pain in the front of your knee and helps you heal faster. You may feel some weakness in your hamstring for a while, but the new ligament made from your tendon is strong and flexible. So, over the time it helps you return to your normal activities.

## Advantages of Getting Your Hamstring Graft for ACL Reconstruction
