

How To Unblock Someone On Snapchat? A Step-by-Step Guide

Unblocking someone on Snapchat simply means the other person can effortlessly see what you've posted on your story. In fact, he/she can readily view your snaps and even your profile. So, do you want to unblock... (or are you simply curious)? Well, here is how you can do it in a few steps!



How to Unblock Someone on Snapchat?

Friends that you block can be unblocked at any time, though they will obviously be able to Snap and Chat you, and see your Stories and Charms once you do so.

- Open **Snapchat**.
- Tap the **profile** icon.
- Open **Settings**
- Move your mouse towards the bottom and tap **Blocked**.
- Click the **✕** next to a **username** to unblock that person on Snapchat.

Note: This method is only applicable for Android and iPhone users. In case you are uncertain about [how to unblock someone on Snapchat on the Web](#), you cannot.

What Happens When You Unblock Someone on Snapchat?

Being unblocked but not on your friend list means that a user will be able to see your Story (provided it is public), find you and your profile in search, and send you Snaps (their first ones).

- Users will not **be alerted about their unblocking**. Nonetheless, they can verify if they are still blocked through other means.
- You will **lose access to old messages** from the unblocked user, but you will be able to receive any new messages.
- Note that you should have attained the **age of 18 years** to receive or send messages to users who are not on your friend list.

Why am I not Able to Unblock Someone?

Read the following reasons that will help you out why you are unable to unblock someone.

- By unblocking someone immediately, it may take up to **24 hours to refresh Snapchat** servers, after which they will appear in your search list again.
- Using an **old version of the Snapchat** application may cause performance issues or functionality issues.
- Also, the **unstable internet or a weak connection** may lead to problems with the fundamental functions in the app.
- **Breaking the Terms of Service of Snapchat** or having your account labeled as suspicious may get your account blocked in a manner that doesn't allow you to perform usual tasks, such as unblocking other users. In this incident, you will be compelled to make contact with the Snapchat support team to have them unlock your account.

How to Add Someone Back?

Use these steps, which will guide you to add the other person to your Snapchat account.

- Open **Snapchat**.
- Tap the **magnifying glass** icon.
- Type the **person's username** or name.
- Click **+ Add** after the user.
