Top 30 Luxury Chalets For Your Christmas Holidays

1) Chalet Edelweiss — Courchevel 1850

4) Chalet Abade — Tignes

Purpose-built for serious skiers and serious relaxing, Abade gets you up early and home happy. The rooms feel like a hush—soft throws, alpine timber, mountain light—while the spa answers every post-slope need. Gather by the fireplace while your private chef plates up Savoyard classics with modern flair.



5) Chalet 1855 — Val d'Isère

Old-wood romance meets contemporary ease. Chalet 1855 is the family favorite where grandparents claim the library nook and kids call dibs on the cinema. Wake to fresh croissants, ski Val's legendary terrain, then return for a hammam and a leisurely dinner.

6) Chalet Mont Tremblant — Méribel

Grand, graceful, and designed for entertaining, Mont Tremblant feels like a private members' club that happens to be a chalet. Expect sun-splashed terraces by day, candlelit pool reflections by night, and an après flow that moves seamlessly from spa to bar to fireside.

7) Etoile du Nord — West Wing — Val d'Isère

A sleek, sculptural retreat tucked into the village fabric, the West Wing pairs wow-factor architecture with comfort you feel the moment boots come off. It's the cocoon you want for Christmas week: views, volume, and a private wellness rhythm that resets you each evening.



8) Etoile du Nord — East Wing — Val d'Isère

Sister to the West, the East Wing turns up the intimacy—more of that hushed, gallery-like feel and a layout that suits families or two-house parties traveling together. Glide back from the slopes, sink into the spa, then linger around the long table as the snow thickens outside.

10) Chalet Gentianes — Courchevel 1850

11) La Grande Roche — Courchevel 1850
