Prerequisites for Enrollment

To enroll in the AHA PALS course near Palm Desert, participants must:

- Hold a current AHA Basic Life Support (BLS) Provider certification
- Have a solid understanding of basic ECG rhythms and pharmacology
- Possess the current PALS Provider Manual or Handbook for ECC (available for purchase during registration)

PDRE also offers a **BART** (**Basic Arrhythmia Recognition and Treatment**) course for students who wish to strengthen their ECG rhythm interpretation before attending PALS training.

Certification and Course Completion

Upon successfully completing all skills and written exams, students receive an **AHA Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) Provider Card**, valid for two years. To pass, participants must:

- Actively participate in all learning sessions
- Score at least 84% on the written exam
- Pass 1- and 2-rescuer Child and Infant CPR AED skills tests
- Successfully lead two PALS core case scenarios (cardiac and respiratory/shock cases)

Continuing Education Credits

Participants may be eligible for **Continuing Medical Education (CME)** and **Continuing Education Units (CEUs)** depending on their professional category. Credits are approved by the **Commission on Accreditation of Pre-Hospital Continuing Education (CAPCE)**.
