This pressure, over the years with time, ends up damaging the ignition switch and requiring <u>car ignition repairs</u>. It is always advisable to keep the keychains simple and light. Avoid putting many keys or decorations on it. One small change in your lifestyle could help your ignition system go a long way.

#### • Turn the Key Gently

This is the reason why forcing your key to turn in the ignition lock, especially when you feel it is stuck, may cause damage to the ignition lock. If your key does not turn easily, try moving the steering wheel slightly while turning the key-I repeat, don't be in a hurry or use an inordinate amount of force. Be gentle in doing so every time you start your car. This will save you a ton of car ignition repairs.



#### • Fix Small Issues Early

It is the key starts sticking or the engine hesitates, don't wait for it to get worse: those are early signs of ignition trouble. Get it checked early to prevent bigger damage. A small fix is far less expensive than a complete ignition replacement. Listen closely to what your car is telling you.



### • Protect It from Dirt and Moisture

Dust, water, or oil may drop anywhere in the ignition and spoil it. As much as possible, keep the car's interior clean, especially around the steering and ignition area. Do not use a dirty or wet key in the ignition. Clean keys and a dry ignition area help the system work better and last longer.
