What Exactly Is in the Fabric?

SLVR Wear™ Signal Shielding Large Blanket uses three layer construction cotton outer layers on both sides for softness and durability, with a silver infused center layer where the conductive, shielding function is concentrated. Why Is There No Single Silver Percentage Listed for the Whole Blanket?

The blanket uses a threelayer approach instead, since a home textile has different comfort and bulk requirements than a garment. Both rely on the same underlying silver conductivity principle, engineered differently for different products.

Will Washing Wear Out the Shielding Over Time?

A woven or structurally integrated conductive layer rather than a coating applied to the surface generally holds up well across normal washing when care instructions are followed gentle cycle, moderate water temperature, low heat or air drying, no fabric softener. A coated or sprayedon approach tends to be more prone to breaking down with repeated washing, which is part of why a structurally integrated construction is the more durable option longterm.

How Do I Pick Between Large and Extra Large?

It comes down to intended use. Large sizing generally suits single adult coverage couch use, desk use, travel. Extra large sizing suits full bedwidth coverage or shared use between two people. If you're unsure, think about where the blanket will be used most often and size accordingly.

Is There Lab Data Specifically for the Blanket?

This is worth answering honestly. [SLVR Wear™](#) published labverified performance data applies specifically to the Silver Scrubs® line, which has undergone that particular testing. Those figures shouldn't be assumed to carry over directly to the blanket, which is built with a different threelayer construction. What can be verified for the blanket is its material composition and construction method, not a blanketspecific lab percentage.
