

10 Reasons Splasherist Should Be Your Next Day Out



Looking for something different to do this year , like an activity that's kind of art class but also a real stress escape and honestly, totally unforgettable? Splasherist might be exactly what you're after. They're known as the UK's leading [rage painting Bristol](#) and splash art studio , and somehow it's become a firm favourite for birthdays, date nights , hen dos, corporate away days, and those "just because" outings. Now they've got studios open in Bath, Bristol, and Worcester so chances are there's one not too far off.

1. You Don't Need Any Artistic Talent

Forget what you think you already know about painting, seriously. Splasherist is made up around the idea that anyone can make something beautiful, even if you're not "skilled" in any obvious way. There are no lessons, no real rules, and no judgement , not really. It's only paint, a canvas, and whatever flashes through your imagination at the time. Whether you're a total beginner or you've been creating for years, the whole experience is meant to stay open and easygoing for everyone , just show up and go.

2. It's a Genuine Stress Release

Rage painting, it's not just one of those trendy phrases, but it actually can be a kind of catharsis. With Splasherist, they give you this private studio space, where you can toss, fling, splatter, and sort of pour paint how you want, no pressure at all. It helps you release pent-up energy in a way that feels freeing, but also kind of constructive. So rather than keeping a stressful week bottled up, you get this chance to physically let it out, and then you just leave with something you made, art you can actually show.

3. Rage Painting in Bath Puts You in the Original Studio

Bath is where Splasherist has their HQ ,and the original studio too, sort of based at 12 Widcombe Parade. It's a solid choice if you want the exact sort of experience that started everything, with room for up to 16 participants downstairs and 10 upstairs. The studio is wheelchair accessible, and there's free one hour parking around the corner, so it comes out as an uncomplicated, low fuss trip whether you're stopping by on your own, as a pair , or with a whole group.

4. Rage Painting in Bristol Offers the Biggest Canvas for Groups

If you're planning something bigger, like a birthday bash , a hen party, or even a work social, rage painting around Bristol is worth a quick look. The Bristol studio, based at Willway Yard, is Splasherist's biggest one , so it can host up to 26 people in one go which is kind of a big deal. It's wheelchair accessible too, plus there is free private on site parking , and they also do a 20% deposit option so group bookings end up easier to organise.



5. Rage Painting in Worcester Brings the Experience to the Midlands

For those who are based further north, a bit of [rage painting Worcester](#) means you don't really need to travel far for the full Splasherist experience. Down at 2 New Street, the Worcester studio opens its doors to as many as 15 participants and it has reduced mobility access, along with a pay-and-display car park that's only about two minutes away. It's quite an intimate space, so it works well for smaller groups or honestly for a more focused solo session.

6. There's an Experience for Every Mood

Splasherist isn't really a one-size-fits-all thing, it's more like a whole menu to pick from, you know:

Splasherist Experience (£35/pp) the original, 50 minute self guided session of pure creative chaos, best from age 5.

VIP Splasherist Experience (£49/pp) same kind of energy but turned up, with bottomless paint, a bigger canvas, and full privacy... yes.

Neon & Splash (£39/pp) a 45 minute UV lit session, using glowing neon paint, for ages 16+.

Splash & Gong (£49/pp) guided and kinda meditative too, where singing bowls and gongs shape your brushstrokes under UV lighting.

Splash & String (£65/pp) a self-guided public workshop with live cello music, for ages 18+.

No matter what you go for , you'll spot a choice that fits the mood you want, from totally wild and high energy to softer, more reflective moments.

7. You Get to Keep Your Artwork

Unlike a lot of those experience days where you just walk away with memories, Splasherist kinda lets you take your finished canvas home with you, up to A3 size that same day, and for bigger formats you can order or set up delivery. It's a proper keepsake, a one of a kind bit of abstract art that also , somehow, doubles as evidence of a genuinely brilliant day out.

8. It's Perfectly Suited to Any Occasion

Splasherist sessions pretty much work for almost any kind of get together, like birthday parties, corporate events, hen parties or stag dos, date nights, family outings, or even those kinda learning trips. Studios around Bath, Bristol and Worcester regularly host these sorts of celebrations, so if you're marking a special occasion, just tell the team what you need at the time of booking.



9. Everything Is Provided Just Bring Your Playlist and Drinks

You really don't have to prep much more than just showing up. Like that's it. Full PPE is on the list for every session : overalls (sizes S–3XL) or a poncho, plus a face shield or goggles, anti-slip shoe covers, and gloves, and then also a bunch of tools, brushes, and accessories so you can splash around with them. The sessions are BYOB-friendly too, so bring your own bottle, and there's a speaker included so you can play your own music while you paint, no big deal. There are lockers for your personal items as well, so you can stash everything safely before you start.

10. It's Backed by Thousands of Happy Guests

With over 5,000 sessions run , and a five-star Google rating, Splasherist has built a kind of loyal following across all three of its studios . People often mention how welcoming the hosts are , how the group vibe feels genuinely fun, and that the minutes basically slip away the second the paint starts flying. So yeah, it's not only a flashy novelty , it feels like a proven experience that actually works.
