From Supporting Roles to Bollywood's Breakout Star

Padda's earliest work barely registered outside industry circles. Her 2022 appearance in *Salaam Venky*, a drama centred on euthanasia, gave her limited screen time alongside veteran actress Kajol, but it was enough to catch the attention of casting teams looking for new talent.

Two years later, she landed her first substantial role, playing Roohi in the Amazon Prime Video coming-of-age series *Big Girls Don't Cry*. Directed by Nitya Mehra, the show followed a group of boarding-school students and it gave Padda far more screen time than her film debut had.
