What Size Scaffolding Does A Small House Usually Need?

structure of the building. It also complies with UK safety standards and guidance. Furthermore, scaffold size depends on working height, lift levels, and elevation width.

What Types Of Domestic Scaffolding Are Commonly Used?

Single Lift

This type of scaffold is used for gutter repairs, painting or small maintenance tasks. It reaches around 3 to 4 metres in heights and provides access to the first storey of a property.

Double Lift

This is ideal for a two-storey cottage, offering two working platforms. Trades people can easily access the roofline safely.

Full House Scaffolding

Planning for larger projects like roof replacement or full renovation? This structure allows access to all sides of the property.

Temporary Roof

Temporary roof scaffolds prevent falls without full vertical staging. This is ideal for major roof repairs or loft conversions.

Factors That Affect the Size of Domestic Scaffolding

Working Height and Lift Levels

The height of your property determines the size of scaffolding. A standard two-storey residential home usually requires two main lifts to reach roof space level safely, while a 3-storey property may require more.

Working Platform Width

Platform width depends on the work type, such as Painting and Inspection and General Building and Roofing. Make sure the width of the scaffold matches the structure.

Site Access and Ground Conditions

Sloping driveways, soft garden soil, or delicate paving affect base stability. Expert installers lay thick timber sole boards beneath adjustable steel baseplates to distribute weight evenly.
